This week we celebrate the rising of MATARIKI/Pleiades – in celebration of praise, and thanks to our God for the provisions of Papatūānuku/Earth, its harvest, our whanau, our challenges and successes - a time to prepare the soil for planting; Pōhutukawa, one of the stars in the Matariki cluster, carries special significance as it connects us to those who have passed during the year. Matariki also symbolizes renewal, life, and hope for the year ahead.
