Our Church is in need of some Roof repair work, the scaffolding and tent will allow the Extreme Roofing to examine our roof and then propose the best way forward for the future of our beautiful Church.

A lot of people have had trouble depositing into the parish bank account with it saying "Not a Match", we hope that we have now finally got this problem sorted.

The parish is now a "registered biller", so when someone goes to make a payment, most banks will have something like "registered payee/biller" select this – then just type in "Dunedin North Parish" and it will come up with the bank details including the number.

If you are making a payment without searching for the registered payee then you will need to use the name "Roman Catholic Bishop of the Diocese of Dunedin" and put in the number and it will come up as a partial match
